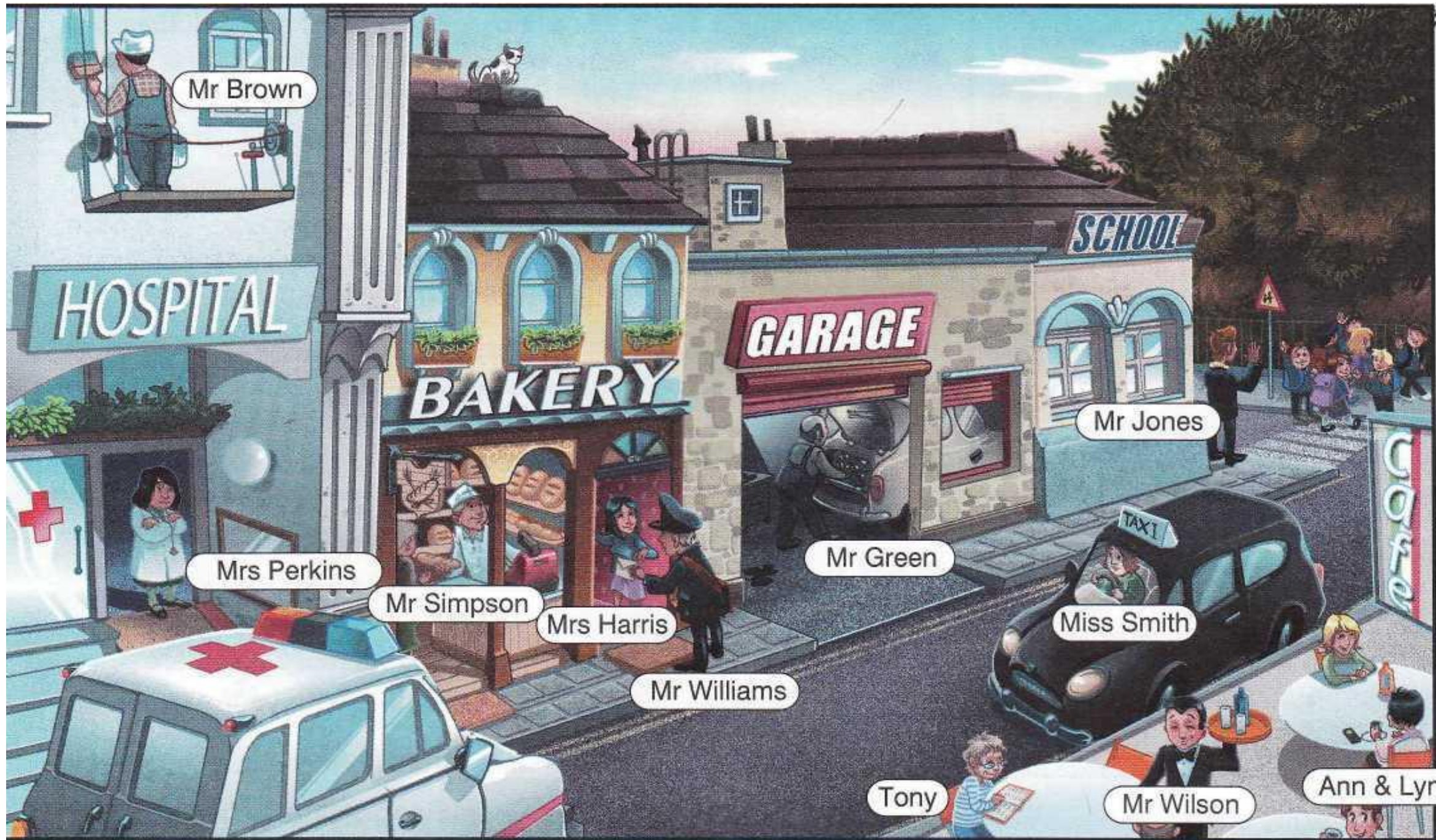

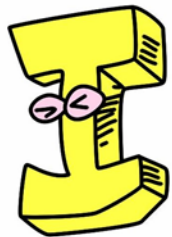

He **could not (couldn't)** write when he was four.

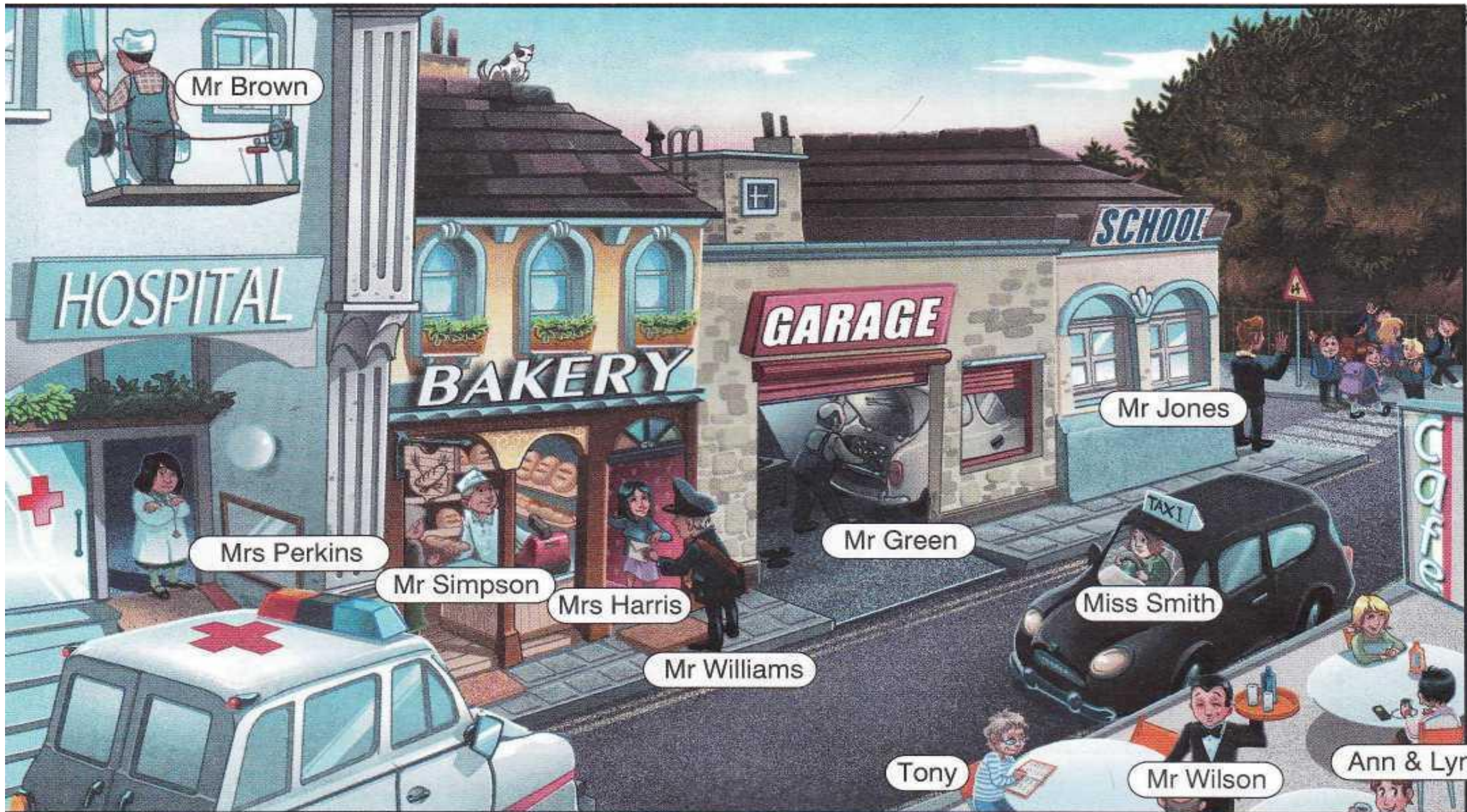

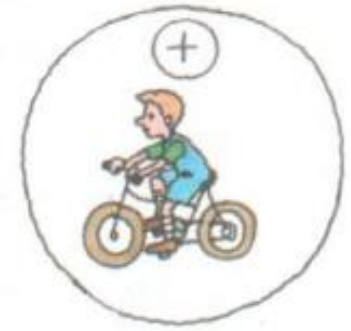

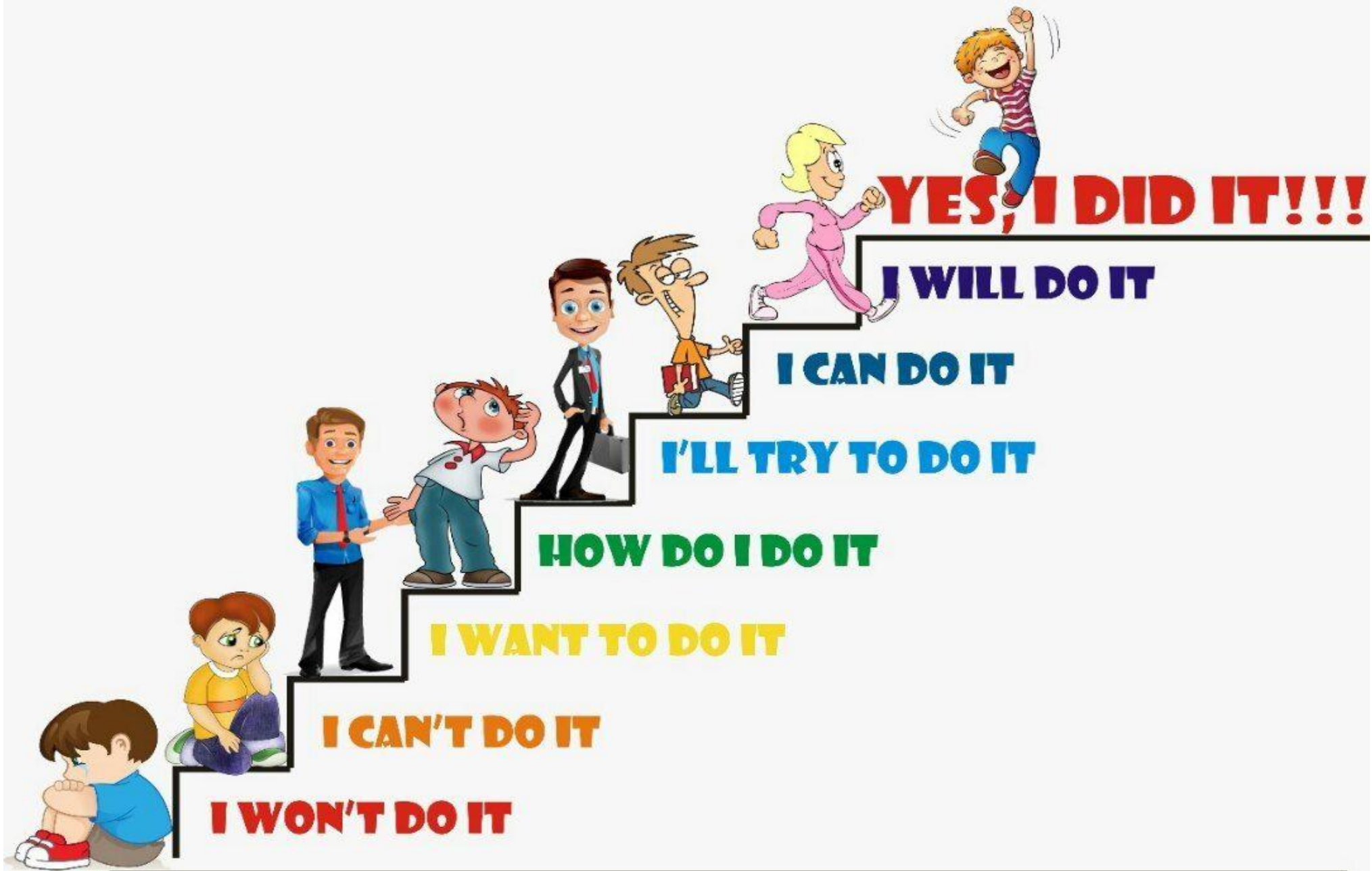
